The following was published in the April 1991 issue of Model Aviation magazine. Eric was a 1990 Charles Hampson Grant Scholarship winner.

Eric Balay of Denver, Colorado, was awarded \$1,000 by the committee. He is a freshman at the University of Colorado at Boulder, studying aerospace engineering. Eric has been an active modeler for five years, having built twelve Radio Control models, five Control Line models, and several Free Flight models. He serves as a flight instructor in his club, the Denver RC Eagles.

A 1990 graduate of East High School in Denver, Eric was listed in *Who's Who in American High School Students*. He was a member of the school band and the Key Club. He was also an active member of the Boy and Eagle Scouts of America and his church youth group.
