The following was published in the March 1988 issue of Model Aviation magazine. Tom was a recipient of the 1987 Carl and Beth Goldberg Vital People Award.

Tom Kozell, of Paoli, Pennsylvania, is a dedicated modeler. He is a designer, builder, flier, and flight instructor. In club life, he has been editor of the Valley Forge Signal Seekers' newsletter for five years. He was named to the national Newsletter Honor Society.

Tom was Winch Master at the 1985 Nats, and in 1986 at the Lincoln Nats, he was Chief Winch Master. Tom acted as Assistant Contest Director for the 1986 Scale Masters, and assumed the role of Contest Director for the 1987 Scale Masters held in Valley Forge. An active worker, strong supporter and an irrepressible conversationalist, Tom has earned his right to be recognized as an unsung hero.
