



2007 F3D Pylon World Championships Muncie, Indiana

Invitation: Every FAI affiliated National Aero Club (National Airport Control Organization) is hereby invited to enter a team to participate in the 2007 F3D Pylon World Championships, to be held at the home of the Academy of Model Aeronautics (International Aeromodeling Center), Muncie, Indiana USA. The 2005 F3D individual World Champion is also invited to attend.

Competition Dates: June 30 – July 4, 2007 (A detailed schedule of events will be included in Bulletin 1). The US Nationals for pylon racing will take place immediately prior to the World Championships. World Championship competitors will be invited to fly in the US Nationals.

Competition Rules: According to the current *FAI Sporting Code*, Section 4 as well as all applicable amendments.

Entry Forms: Preliminary Entry Forms will be included with *Bulletin 1*. Official Entry Forms will be included with *Bulletin 2*.

Fees: Obligatory fees are as follows: Pilots/Team Managers- \$350.00 USD, Callers-\$125.00 USD. Supporters: \$100.00 USD.

Organizers: The Academy of Model Aeronautics.

Site Location: The World Championships will be held in Muncie, Indiana USA. This 1000 acre model flying site is the home and headquarters of the Academy of Model Aeronautics. Four 700' long runways are available. Three runways feature a paved surface the fourth is a grass surface. The World Championships will be conducted on the center paved runway area. This complex is set-up for pylon specifically. Ample room exists on this site practice areas. Also featured on the site is the National Model Aviation Museum. Tours of the facilities and the AMA Headquarters operation will be available during the World Championships.

Frequency
Information:**

Only transmitters on frequencies legal in the United States may be operated in the United States. These are specific channels in the 72 MHz band only. These modules & receivers are currently available from the major radio manufacturers in the US. Further information will be available in *Bulletin 1*. The 2.4 GHz band may also be available should full range transmitter/receivers be available by the World Championships. Use of transmitters in the 2.4 GHz band must be approved by the AMA Technical Director.
