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Why Clubs May Need Additional Liability Protection

Many clubs require coverage for other people or groups. Such coverage is provided by means of an “Additional Insured” Certificate issued under the AMA liability insurance policy. Such certificates are valid so long as the club is chartered and serve to provide \$2,500,000 of primary liability insurance coverage to non-AMA persons or organizations (flying site owners, sponsors, governments or organizations).

For a newly chartered club, AMA’s receipt of the club application, certificate request and required fees will activate policy coverage for that club and for the additional insured as well, except for those requiring “specially worded” certificates. The coverage will continue through the policy expiration date of March 31 of each year unless the charter application is rejected, in which case the club coverage and the additional insured coverage is terminated. Notice will be sent to the club with information stating why the charter application was not deemed acceptable.

All Clubs will be issued a Chartered Club Certificate as proof by AMA of both chartering and liability coverage by the current insurance carrier. Only clubs that apply for additional insurance will receive a separate certificate naming the additional insured. Request for additional insurance must be received at AMA in writing or by E-mail, accompanied by proper fees and **authorized signature of a current club officer**. Please use this form.

For a club which has renewed its charter and wishes to continue site owner coverage, a copy of the expiring certificate OR the computerized summary report provided by AMA listing a club’s certificate(s) should be used in place of this form. All requests without proper payment will be returned to the club contact. Please note any requested changes on the computerized form or the certificate copy to be returned.

The original and one copy of the certificate is mailed to the designated club contact. NOTE: It is the responsibility of the club to forward this proof of insurance to the additional insured. Corrections to certificates already issued must also be requested in **writing by the designated club officer**, and will usually be furnished at no additional charge.

There is a \$60.00 charge for each regular certificate issued. If you have any questions, call the Club Secretary (extension 291) at AMA HQ. Should you require a special wording, indoor Electric, or special form certificates, a \$80.00 charge will apply. The application form is available on the AMA Web site, Document 535-H. For more information, please contact Special Services (extension 251).

Certificates that are valid for a specific date only are still available for \$20.00 (regular) and \$30.00 (special wording).

To receive a site insurance certificate in those situations where there are multiple clubs using the same site. There are two options: the first being each club shall submit an application for a certificate of insurance; the second option is the clubs shall choose to form a Chapter and submit an application for a single certificate of insurance in the name of the Chapter.
