

## Welcome to Control Line Precision Aerobatics at the 2010 AMA Nationals.

For events 322 (Open) and 325 (JSO), the first official day of flying is Wednesday July 14<sup>th</sup>.

- ✓ Your models need to be present on Monday, July 12<sup>th</sup>, at 2:30 PM, at the 180 Building in Muncie for processing.
- ✓ Similar to last year, please present your models in *flying configuration only*.
- ✓ Do **NOT** bring special props, spinners, landing gear, or any other device that will affect the flying qualities of your aircraft.
- ✓ This is necessary as we weigh the aircraft to determine the pull test and line size requirements.
- ✓ If your aircraft weighs close to 64 ounces, and you are using 0.015" lines, be very sure it is less than 64 ounces so there will be no surprises. Likewise, if you are flying on 0.018" lines, be sure your plane is less than 75 ounces.
- ✓ The scale that will be used for the weigh-in will be checked for accuracy before use.
- ✓ Following the weigh in, there will be a pilots meeting. We have a pilots roll call, and will draw for circle assignment and flight order.

Junior and Senior pilot's flight and processing information.

- ✓ Jr/SR (JS) pilot's entered in 322 need not attend the Monday Pilots Meeting.
- ✓ 322 (J,S) official flying is on Saturday, July 17<sup>th</sup>.
- ✓ Appearance judging for 322 (J,S) will be on Friday morning at 7:30 A.M. on the "L" pad.
- ✓ Any (JS) entered in 325 must attend the processing and Pilots Meeting on Monday

As in past years, the grass field is available for practice prior to the start of official flying.

- ✓ Due to other large scale RC events, the grass field is off limits for safety reasons prior to Friday.
- ✓ The road leading to that area will also be closed during those events.
- ✓ The grass field will be open starting on Friday July 9<sup>th</sup> for your use.

Flying is **not** allowed prior to 7:00 a.m. Please do not create an issue by flying before that time. This restriction is not due to the noise from the CLPA planes. It is from "other" noise, so all flying has been limited to a 7:00 am start. Please do not violate this restriction.

- ✓ A schedule of events is also enclosed.
- ✓ Please note the time your event starts, and please be prompt.
- ✓ Know your flight order, and have your plane available for pull test a minimum of three flights prior to your scheduled flight time.
- ✓ When your flight is completed, please roll up your lines and make room for others preparing to fly.
- ✓ For pilots entered in unofficial events, be sure to register at NATs headquarters prior to your event registration.
- ✓ All pilots must check in at NATs headquarters prior to flying.

Please understand that we are at the mercy of the weather. We will do everything possible to get in your scheduled flights, in as even and timely a manner as possible.
