AMA Competition Regulations Rules Change Proposal Form

Applicable Competition Regulations this proposal relates to: Outdoor Free Flight

Give Brief Summary of the Proposed Change:

An RDT system is required in A and B Electric models with wing spans exceed 36 inches. The RDT must be able to stop the motor if running, followed by an instant DT of the horizontal stabilizer or wing.

State exact wording proposed for the Competition Regulations. List paragraph number where applicable. Example: Change "quote present rule book wording" to "exact wording required".

Add a new paragraph:

Remote Dethermalizer (RDT).

RDT is required in Class A Electric (160) and B Electric (161) models if their projected wing spans exceed 36 inches. The RDT must be able to stop the motor if running, and release a flight surface to initiate a rapid descent (dethermalizer).

Proper operation of the RDT system must be demonstrated before the first official flight. The flyer or their helper must hold or carry the RDT's transmitter at each launch.

State logic behind proposed change, including alleged shortcoming of the present rule(s).

A and B Electric models are unlimited in terms of size, weight and power. They are fast and heavy with high kinetic energy and can potentially cause significant injuries or collateral damage in a crash under power.

E-36 models flying in A or B electric are exempt due to their small size and weight. However, it is good practice to equip E36s with RDT systems to reduce crashing under power. RDT systems are available from Texas Timers, Airtek, BMK and Aeris. Standalone RDT units powered by their own battery are also available.
