The following was published in the April 1991 issue of Model Aviation magazine. Anthony was a 1990 Charles Hampson Grant Scholarship winner.

Anthony Hutchins of Portland, Indiana, received \$1,000 to assist in his studies. He is enrolled at Purdue University in the Aeronautic Technology program.

With the help of his father and grandfather, Anthony was introduced to Free Flight modeling at a young age. He has won several Junior Free Flight events at the 1985 and 1986 National Championships. He was also a member of the team that represented the United States at the Junior World Free Flight Championships in Poland.

A graduate of Jay County High School, Anthony was a four-year member of the National Honor Society. He was also involved in the French Club, Latin Club, and the varsity golf and tennis teams. Additionally, he participated in the PRIDE (Patriots Reducing Intoxicated Driving Everywhere) program.
