Ryan Stauffer was awarded \$4,000 by the committee. A native of Winston-Salem, North Carolina, he is a freshman at the University of North Carolina-Charlotte studying mechanical engineering and computer science.

Ryan, who enjoys Radio Control and Control Line flying, is a member of the Riverside Aeromodelers. He has competed in numerous local contests and assisted his club by registering contestants and judging Helicopter events. He has also flown models in demonstrations for Scout groups.

He graduated second in his class from North Forsyth High School. During his high school years, he was active in many organizations including the National Honor Society, the Vocational Honor Society, the Key Club, the Spanish Club, the Computer Club, and the school newspaper. Active in the community, he has served as a volunteer to the Red Cross, Brenner Children's Hospital, and the Crisis Control Ministry.
