AMA "expert" flight sequence is intended to (in perpetuity) always follow the current flight sequence of F3C "preliminary" maneuvers of whatever year it is.

AMA Expert helicopter class shall follow current (in perpetuity) year of event F3C preliminary flight maneuvers only. One sequence only (not multiple as in F3C).
