District 8 Candidates

Mike Clark, Dallas, Texas, AMA 6295 (CD) was born on November 7, 1940 in Marshall, Texas. He lived in Longview, Texas from 1949 until 1959, then attended Texas A&M College from 1959 to 1963.

He joined the Philadelphia Eagles in 1963, was with the Pittsburgh Steelers from 1964-1967, and from 1968 until 1974, Mike was Place Kicker for the World Champion Dallas Cowboys with whom he went to the 1970 and 1971 NFL Super Bowls. He had a total of 11 active NFL years.

In 1974 Mike joined Oak Cliff Bank and Trust in the Marketing department. After seven years at the bank, he is now a department head.

For the past four years, Mike was one of the directors of the Southwest Modelers Show in Dallas. Active in RC for 12 years, he is married and the father of two boys, ages nine and thirteen.

Time does permit an active AMA representation by Mike for District VIII.
