Occupation, manufacturing engineering group leader, Grumman Aircraft Eng. Corp. Age 32. Twenty years a modeler, 12 years a Contest Director/Leader Member. AMA vice-president 1961-1962; MA contest board 1959; various offices in Greater New York Interclub organization, Long Island Association of Model Airplane Clubs, Sky-scrapers. Interests: Free flight (FAI power, gliders, rubber in particular); indoor; has flown control-line competitively, dabbled in RC; licensed pilot (350 hours, some glider time). Aims: Increased AMA effort toward: flying site assistance program, improved public relations, exploitation of Model Aviation as commercial technical magazine and membership building tool, improved international programs.
